We devoted the entire issue of *The Feast International* April 2021 to the Feast Conference 2020 re-run for our International Feasts.



Peace to me didn't seem important. But it's my Number One now. I really believe that it is a gift from God and we need to treasure it.



DECEMBER 2021 FEAST LIGHT JACKSON HEIGHTS


Amid the COVID Pandemic still with us as of this writing! people felt it was not going to be a Merry Christmas.
