

FEAST QATAR YEAR 10



FEAST QATAR has relentlessly pursued the core mission of our faith community, the Light of Jesus (LOJ) Family-- the mission mandated by our Lord Jesus to His disciples before He ascended to Heaven: *Go and make disciples of all nations*. (Matthew 28:19).

By God's amazing grace, our Light of Jesus Family, which started on September 1980, has well flourished, making disciples worldwide, including Qatar.

In 2006, Oliver Hubalde would arrive with his wife Marj and daughters Bea and Kiana in Doha, Qatar's capital.

And seven years later, Feast Qatar would be born--on June 1, 2012. Thus, this June 1, 2022, Feast Qatar celebrates its 10th Founding Anniversary.




Here is the family now, from left: Olie, Marj, Bea, Gabie, and Kiana.

Blessed Beginnings

Olie started young in his faith journey. In the Philippines, back in the early 1990s, he joined the Ministry for the youth of our Light in Jesus Family, called Youth Mission for Parishes and Communities (YMPACT). After graduating from college, he served as a full-time staff of YMPACT. He also joined LOJ's Music Ministry.

Thirsty with the spiritual nourishment he received in LOJ, Olie would naturally find his way to the LOJ in Doha, the capital and most populous city of the State of Qatar, the peninsular Arab country in the Persian Gulf.



As the maps show, Qatar is a peninsula located east of Arabia bordering the Persian Gulf and Saudi Arabia. Surrounded with sea water, Qatar boasts of close to 150 species of fish—snapper, grouper, sea bass, and tuna. So, not a few Qatar residents are fishermen.

Qatar is also a fishing ground—for fishers of men. Remember, 2,000 years ago, walking beside the Sea of Galilee, Jesus saw two fishermen-- Simon and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea.

Jesus told them, "Come, follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." -- Matthew 4: 19.

Later, the Lord then blessed Simon with the name *Peter*, meaning *Rock*, telling him: "I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades will not overpower it." – Matthew 16: 18.

Our Catholic doctrine points out that this mandate of our Lord Jesus is the basis for the papal succession—bishops of Rome becoming Peter's successors—and the papacy remains to this day as the foundation of our Church.

Year 1 to Year 10

Fast forward to 2012. In May of that year, 30 Filipinos based in Doha attended a one-day Living in the Light Series (LLS) held by Light of Jesus Family. They graduated on May 11, 2012.

Experiencing intense spiritual awakening, the graduates then formed The Feast Qatar on June 1, 2012, starting with a Feast Video – watching on video the Feast talks of our founder, Bro. Bo Sanchez.

By God's grace, the Feast Video transitioned to a *live* Feast on September 6, 2013. And flourishes to this day.

To date, Feast Qatar counts 90-100 members meeting every Friday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the assigned rooms at the Bishop Paul Hinder building at the Our Lady of the Rosary Catholic Church.

Feast Qatar thrives through the exemplary members of the Servant-Leader Council: Feast Builder Bro. Oliver "Olie" Hubalde, ably supported by his wife Marj; Glenn and Jane Caruz, Events Ministries; Edith Manuel, Evangelization and Fellowship Ministries; Mary Ann Gonzaga, Finance and Administration; Rommel and Nymia Marcaida, Singles Ministry.

DISCIPLES AROUND THE WORLD

I Was Afraid To Open Up By JAMES RHODERICK G. ERICE

I'VE been familiar with faith gatherings since way back in the early years of 2000.

I had attended a few Christian prayer meetings and even those held by Catholic Charismatic communities. But for one reason or another, I could not commit to attend regularly.

In hindsight, I was uneasy about opening up--my doubts, fears, and pains-with other individuals not named Pam, my ever-loving wife (*right*).

Then came 2016. A friend invited Pam and me to join the Light of Jesus Family weekly faith gathering called The Feast in Qatar.

And here, I first experienced the warmth and welcoming vibe of LOJ.



In LOJ Feasts, participants are divided into small groups of about 10 members called Light Groups who usually meet after The Feast to share reactions or reflections on the Feast talk, and to support each other in their faith journey. Pam and I became members of a Light Group with four awesome couples, so friendly, that I somehow began to drop my guard.

Turning Point

On April 19, 2018 -- I remember the date very well because on this day I experienced a turning point in my faith journey--for the first time, I found myself confidently sharing with our members my thoughts about family life, good -- and not so good-- life experiences, and my plans.



I've Changed!

Indeed, my fear of expressing my deepest thoughts gradually vanished.

And so, I've been able to open up not only with my Light Group, but with my family as well. I've had intimate conversations with my wife and our three children --all young adults now.

Here they are in front of me during our visit in Canada: Pam, Jerick, Jam, and Jaz.

And then, I've been able to share my thoughts and feelings also with my folks back home. Where before I had only intermittent calls with them, now I enjoy almost daily Messenger chats with themplus video calls at least once a week.

I believe I've changed because at The Feast, I've learned more about God and His unconditional love—manifested through my co-Feasters who have accepted me the way I am, listening to me without judgment, so that I am able to speak out what's in my heart.

Yes, my spiritual development is still a long and, at times, difficult journey. But with LOJ's support, I am no longer afraid for I know I will continue



to be blessed with this very life-changing experience.

Because God promises in Isaiah 41:13:

¹³ For I hold you by your right hand—
I, the LORD your God.
And I say to you,
'Don't be afraid. I am here to help you.

JUNE 5, 2022: PENTECOST DAY Stay, Stand, Speak

But there was a radical shift. After the Holy Spirit came upon them, the disciples were changed. From being cowards, hiding in the Upper Room in Jerusalem, they became fearless. They marched out of that room ready to die for Jesus. And years later, they did. All the apostles, except John the Beloved, became martyrs.

Today, most of us may not be called to do the same and be martyrs for the Faith. But I believe that the call of Jesus for everyone is still here: That is to *Receive His Spirit*. This is the message we want to preach to you today.


The Light of Jesus Pastoral Care Center ministers to those who are emotionally and spiritually wounded.
