

Review the story of Joseph— how his brothers threw him into a pit and sold him as a slave. Because they hated him and wanted him punished. But God turned it into good. Through a circuitous route, Joseph became the governor of Egypt.

The key message of Talk 3, *“God will turn it into good,”* comes from what Joseph told his brothers: *You plotted evil against me, but God turned it into good...* (Genesis 50:20 GNT).

But note, this didn’t happen automatically. Joseph was seduced by Potiphar’s wife, and he resisted her allures. If he gave in to her temptation, I suspect God’s plan would not have happened. But because he followed God, God turned evil into good. When you have a strong spiritual character, curses become blessings.

But the opposite happens too. When you’re spiritually unprepared for the harvest, disaster strikes. Blessings become curses.

Your entire life is built on one foundation—your spiritual character. If your spiritual character isn’t strong, the weight of your blessings will crush you. This is what spiritual character means: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. (Galatians 5:22-23 NIV)

II. ASK FOR REACTIONS AND REFLECTIONS

Ask for sharing on the three temptations in life you need to fight at every stage, but they all increase in Stage 3...

- 1. Temptations to Lust
- 2. Temptations to Greed
- 3. Temptations to Pride

Ask: for sharing on the 4 Strategies To Protect Yourself from Temptations of Entitlement:

- Strategy 1: Lead with a Limp**
- Strategy 2: Protect with Partners**
- Strategy 3: Monitor Your Marriage**
- Strategy 4: Connect with Your Core**

III. PRAY FOR EACH OTHER

Pray that members may be protected from temptations so that they can focus, concentrate on what God really wants them to do.

Pray that members will always remember the four strategies to protect themselves from temptations.

Pray for those who have fallen. Pray David’s prayer:
“Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; accord- ing to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!” (Psalm 51:1-2)

Pray that they will remember: God is found in your detours as much as in your destination.

Pray God, we allow You to form our spiritual character, so that our curses will turn into blessings.

Declare: Beside where I fell, I find a winning ladder, and beside my delay, I’ll find a doorway to my destiny. God will turn it into good.
